#### Habit 7: Sharpen the Saw


I take care of my body by eating right, exercising, and getting sleep.

Earth Day: First graders work with fourth grade buddies to practice their gardening skills and what they have learned about what plants need to grow.










## March Staff Member of the Month - Ms. Ella Darby

These are just some of the students who have been recognized for showing leadership skills in school.


- <u>Kindergarten</u> **Trinity W.** (Ms. Demarest's class): "She helped a friend overcome her fears." - -Ms. Demarest
